Ready for some great summertime fun? We'll be using the Town Beach, HES library, gym, and cafeteria as well as the playground and ball fields. Our staff will be Bridges teachers, HES staff and high school students, so we'll be in small groups with lots of interesting activities: morning swim lessons, Project of the Day, games, nature, art & drama, free swim at the end of the day and a special field trip the last week. Our ratios are usually 5:1. We'll provide a tasty, cool afternoon snack and a pizza party every Friday.

Please complete the registration form and **return this form with a \$100 non-refundable deposit per session to the Community Education OFFICE.** *Enrollment is open to Harvard Residents and School Choice students. Students must be entering grades 1-6 in the Fall of 2008. Space is limited and filled on a first come first served basis.*

### *An example of a "typical" day:*

9-11:45 a.m. - Morning rotation would be Swim lessons at the pond, Project of the Day with Mrs. B., and Games in the gym or on the field with Jordan and Kailey.

Lunch and Meeting: 11:45-12:30 p.m.

12:30-2:30 p.m. - Afternoon rotation activities include Art with Ms. Mary, Drama with Andy and Science and Nature with Ms. Lisa

2:30-2:45 p.m. Ice Cream Snack

2:45-3:45 p.m. is Free Choice Time. Activities can include: Free Swim at the pond, games in the gym or on the field, and the Bridges Room for blocks, computer or board games, drawing etc.

4:00 p.m. Parent Pick up

After Program care is available from 4:00 p.m.-5:30 p.m. for an additional fee (see registration form).

**Dates of Note: Friday, July 11th** is the date for the Bridges Summer Adventure Theater Performance. Children will perform the play they have been working hard on for the first two weeks of our program. They create the sets, help with costumes, work "back-stage" and memorize their lines. It's amazing to see the end product in just 2 short weeks! The **Water Show at the Pond will be Friday, July 18th.** Parents are invited to come watch the show! The children in each swim level share what they have learned during their 4 weeks of lessons. During the week of July 21st the children will be heading to the Ecotarium\* in Worcester for a fun-filled field trip!

**Swimming lesson notes:** Lessons are 4 weeks and begin on June 23rd. Bridges staff bring the children to lessons only while they are registered with us. Week 4 (July 14 week) is testing week, ending with the Water Show on the 18th. If you do not want your child to participate in swimming lessons, please circle "no lessons" on the registration.

Tuition balance is due by **May 15th.** You will receive a confirmation letter and required forms within 4 weeks of the date we receive your registration. All forms, including current physical (within 13 months of program dates) are due in the Community Education office by **June 15th.**
