



# Bridges Summer Adventure Program

## Theme: Something Fishy!

for students entering Grades 1 - 6 Fall 2010

Come join us for a fun time in July!

Ready for some great summertime fun? We'll be using the Town Beach (we register children for swim lessons run by the Harvard Park & Recreation Committee), Bridges rooms, HES library, gym, and cafeteria as well as the playground and ball fields. We have an awesome staff who work within the school system during the year and really get to know the children. They are Lisa Robichaud, Learning Assistant, Mary Sullivan, Artist, Andy Sawyer, Artist/Filmmaker and Jen Baranowski, Learning Assistant. Our support staff are Bromfield students who have attended our programs. We'll be in small groups with lots of interesting activities: Morning swim lessons (session I only), Project of the Day, games, nature, art & drama, optional free swim at the end of the day and our drama performance at the end of session I on July 16. We will have a special field trip to the New England Aquarium planned for the last week of the program. Our ratios are usually 5:1. We'll provide a tasty, cool afternoon snack and a pizza party every Friday.

Please complete the registration form and **return this form with a \$100 non-refundable deposit per session to the Community Education Office.** *Enrollment is open to Harvard Residents and School Choice students. Students must be entering grades 1-6 in the Fall of 2010. Space is limited and filled on a first-come first-served basis.*

### An example of a "typical" day:

9:00-11:45 a.m. - Morning rotation would be Swim lessons at the pond (session I), Project of the Day, and Games in the gym or on the field.

11:45-12:30 p.m. - Lunch and meeting



12:30-2:30 p.m. - Afternoon rotation activities include Art, Drama, Science and Nature



2:30-2:45 p.m. Ice Cream Snack



2:45-3:45 p.m. is Free Choice Time. Activities can include: Daily art projects exploring different mediums, printmaking, animation, painting in special on-going studio art workshops, tie-dye, free swim at the pond, games in the gym or on the field.

4:00 p.m. Parent Pick up *After Program care is available from 4:00 p.m.-5:30 p.m. for an additional fee (see registration form).*

**Dates of Note:** **Friday, July 16th** is the date for the **Bridges Summer Adventure Theater Performance.** Children will perform the play **"Peter Pan"** for parents and friends. During the first two weeks of our program they create the sets, help with costumes, work "back-stage" and memorize their lines. It's amazing to see the end product in just 2 short weeks! No after program care is available on this day. In keeping with our "Fish" theme, the week of **July 26th** we will go on a fun-filled field trip to the **New England Aquarium.** **July 30th** is our last day, **Pirate Party!**

**Swimming lesson notes:** Lessons are 2 weeks in length. Bridges Summer Adventure will participate in swimming lessons only during the first session of our program. Bridges staff bring the children to lessons (children with early lessons are dropped off at the pond by parents and check in with our staff). If you do not want your child to participate in swimming lessons, please circle "no lessons" on the registration.



Tuition balance is due by **May 21st.** You will receive a confirmation letter and required forms within 4 weeks of the date we receive your registration. All forms, including current physical (within 13 months of program dates) are due in the Community Education office by **June 11th.**
