

School Committee Member Qualifications / Oath of Office

In order to serve on the School Committee, an individual must be a registered voter in the town from which he/she is elected or appointed, and he/she must take an oath of office before an officer duly qualified to administer oaths prior to entering into his/her official duties as a member of the Committee.

As required by law, all newly qualified Committee members will receive from the Town Clerk, and sign a receipt for a copy of the Massachusetts open meeting law governing the conduct of Committee meetings in general and executive sessions in particular.
