

Operation of Food Services

The School Committees goal is to provide healthy, nutritious meals to the students who avail themselves of these meals, with the belief that this will support student learning. The Manager of Food Services is responsible for developing a program in consistent with standards including food quality and sanitation. Meals shall be delivered in a courteous and respectful manner. Cost of school lunches shall be consistent with state laws and regulations and with the desire of the School Committee to make the school lunch program as self-supportive as possible.

The Superintendent shall assign personnel and other resources as required to provide cafeterias at each school which will serve lunches to students as required by state laws and regulations and shall develop procedures and accounting practices which will enable the food services program to receive the maximum possible financial assistance from state and federal sources so that costs to students can be kept at a minimum.

The cost of school lunches to students and staff shall be set by the Manager of Food Services and submitted to the School Committees for approval.
