

RELATIONS WITH BOOSTER ORGANIZATIONS

The School Committee recognizes that the endeavors and objectives of booster organizations and similar groups can be a valuable means of stimulating interest in and endorsement of the aims and achievements of our public school district. Generally, actions initiated by boosters provide the atmosphere and climate to foster and encourage community-school relationships. Booster-proposed plans, projects, or activities must be evaluated by the administration and promoted in light of their stated contribution to the academic as well as the athletic and fine arts programs of the schools. Plans, projects or activities of booster organizations will not compromise or dilute the responsibilities and authorities of the School Committee.

Participation in the fundraising activities of booster organizations will not determine the participation of any student in any school-sponsored activity.

The School Committee encourages that all fundraisers done by boosters:

1. Allow sufficient time/notification to participating students
2. Are completely voluntary.
3. In no way penalize a student from participation in all team or group activities.
