

How to sign-up for a BPL eCard

(Boston Public Library's Electronic Card)

Where is the registration form? Go to **bpl.org**
Click on **My Account**
Click on the button that says **Get a BPL eCard**
Fill in the fields (boxes). (Note: a phone # is NOT required for registration)
Click the **I Accept** button at the bottom of the page

- Once registered successfully, you will get a barcode number to use, along with your selected PIN #.
- **SAVE** your **BARCODE #** and **PIN** to a secure location (e.g., email, TBS student account, etc.)
- You will be asked to supply this information each time you access the BPL's electronic resources.

BPL eCards are virtual library cards that allow users immediate entry to all of Boston Public Library's remotely-accessible electronic resources, including magazine databases, downloadable audio, video, e-books, and music. eCard users who wish to check out library materials will be asked to upgrade to a standard BPL card (see below).
