SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:

Dr. Dwight shared her submitted report as follows:

- **New Furniture Arrived:** New cafeteria tables arrived at Bromfield right before the Thanksgiving Break. There is a mixture of high top and circular tables to give students a choice of seating.
- **DEIB Focused Student Forums to Begin Soon:** Marisa Khurana, DEIB Coordinator, is organizing lunchtime forums with students to review the culture data from the survey given in Spring 2022. Students will have an opportunity to discuss and share ideas for improvements to the school culture.
- **Fall Theater Successes:** Students in the Bromfield drama programs provided entertainment to families on November 18-20. Congratulations to the students and their drama and music teachers!
- **Sports Successes:** Over November 18-20, students represented Bromfield at the state cross country meet and soccer finals. The girls' cross country team finished 4th and the boys' team finished 6th. The boys' soccer team won their fifth state title - a record in the league!
